

# Adult Girl Scout Insignia Placement

Below are some of the most common Adult Girl Scout insignia & recognitions. For details on others, see *Girl Scout Uniforms, Insignia, and Recognitions*. On uniform shirts that have an embroidered *Girl Scouts* on the left side, the pins are worn above the embroidery, but on some of the shirts, the embroidery is so high, that the pins would be too close to the shoulder seam. In that case, the pins look better worn below the embroidery.

#1 - The Girl Scout Pin, Traditional or Contemporary is worn on the left side, over the heart. The miniature versions of the Girl Scout Pins are never worn on a Girl Scout uniform.

#2 - Above the Girl Scout Pin is the World Trefoil Pin. The miniature version of the World Trefoil Pin is not worn on a Girl Scout uniform.

#3 - Centered between the Girl Scout Pin and the World Trefoil Pin is the adult position pin. If you have more than one position, you may wear up to two pins, side by side (or “stacked” if you’re using an insignia tab). If you hold more than two positions (i.e. Junior GS Leader, Brownie GS Consultant and Trainer), you select the two most appropriate pins for the occasion. The most common color pins are:

- Yellow - Leaders, Assistant Leaders, Co-Leaders
- Red - Service Unit Team Members
- Chartreuse - Trainers
- Beige - Employed Staff

#4 - Membership numerals are worn to the right of the Girl Scout Pin. They can be a little difficult to fit on an insignia tab, but it can be done!

#5 - The Girl Scout name tag is worn on the right opposite the Girl Scout Pin.

#6 - Centered above the name tag (or a virtual name tag if you’re not wearing one), you wear one of these recognitions. If you’ve received more than one of these recognitions, you wear the last one you received:

- Thanks Badge
- Thanks Badge II
- Honor Pin
- Appreciation Pin

#7 - Centered below the name tag (or a virtual name tag if you’re not wearing one) you wear one of the following:

- Girl Scout Gold Award
- First Class Pin
- Curved Bar
- Golden Eaglet

Things get a little more complicated here! If you haven’t received one of these recognitions, move your Years of Service Pin (#8) into this position. If you haven’t received a Years of Service Pin, you can place one of the of recognitions from group #9 in this position.

#8 - Place your Years of Service Pin below your Gold Award (group #7). If you have not received a Gold Award, move your Years of Service Pin up, level with group #9.

#9 - On either side of the Gold Award, you wear two of these recognitions. If you have more than two of these, select the two that are most appropriate for the event:

- Leadership Development Pin
- Trainer’s Pin
- Outstanding Volunteer Award
- Outstanding Leader Award

To summarize:

- A maximum of two positions pins can be worn (#3) on the left
- A maximum of one recognition above the name tag (#4) on the right
- A maximum of four recognitions below the name tag (#6, #7, #8, #9) on the right
